

CAPACITY BUILDING: Strengthening the capacity of anti-corruption officers on Financial Investigation (Corruption) Workshop

The CAACC is collaborating with Malkara Consulting Pty (Ltd) to run a face-to-face workshop titled Financial Investigation (Corruption) for the Directorate on Corruption and Economic Crime, Botswana Police Service, Financial Intelligence Agency and Non-Banking Financial Institutions Regulatory Authority from the 12th-23rd September 2022 in Gaborone.

The program is designed to meet the needs of corruption agencies involved in investigation of corruption and money laundering under the four main objectives;

- 1. Identification and reporting of corruption and money laundering
- 2. Investigation and prosecution of corruption and money laundering
- 3. Asset forfeiture

The ten-day program will be comprised of formal presentations, specific syndicate exercises, review tests, videos etc. and will cover topics such as corruption activity in Botswana, introduction to bribery and corruption and money laundering methods (non-financial businesses and professions). The program will be resourced by an experienced facilitator from Malkara Consulting Pty (Ltd).

Participants: Twenty-five (25) officers from DCEC, FIA, NBFIRA and Botswana Police Service are nominated to attend the workshop.
